

100 Men Club donates nearly \$14,000 to BLOOMFIELD SCAMP providing children with disabilities a therapeutic summer camp experience.

DETROIT, MI — July 3, 2018 — 100 Men Club, a group of local men committed to making a positive difference within the Metro Detroit communities and their families, announced its latest donation to **BLOOMFIELD SCAMP** for \$13,700.

At their June meeting, three charities were nominated, and the membership voted to donate that evening's proceeds to BLOOMFIELD SCAMP. The nomination was made by 100 Men Club member William Haines, "This donation will enable SCAMP to enrich the lives of even more local families, offering kids a chance to have an unforgettable summer camp experience." Haines added, "I learned about this organization through my wife, who has worked as a special education teacher at Bloomfield Schools and dedicated her summers to SCAMP for 8 years. Having volunteered myself, I've seen the joy this camp brings to kids, and I am proud the 100 Men Club could help further their efforts."

Scamp is a 5-week summer program that seeks to provide an exciting and therapeutic summer program for individuals with disabilities ages 3-26 in the Metro Detroit Area. Bloomfield SCAMP was founded in 1967 and was the first summer camp in our area to provide a summer program for individuals with disabilities. Campers enjoy a variety of structured activities that focus on social skills improvement, and pre-vocational skills while at SCAMP. They also enjoy art and music therapy and physical education. Participants in this program will swim at Walnut Lake which is located behind West Hills Middle School in West Bloomfield.

"We strive to make each summer the best for our participants and work to build partnerships with parents, teachers, community agencies and other school personnel to help each individual grow and also enjoy the recreational opportunities provided by SCAMP", said Emily Price, Bloomfield SCAMP Coordinator.

"This generous donation from the 100 Men Club will allow us to offer more scholarships to campers in need as well as support the transport of campers from the surrounding Metro-Detroit area. With these funds we will have the opportunity to provide special events and programming, like music therapy, during camp sessions," says Jessi Haines, Bloomfield SCAMP Assistant Coordinator.

Each quarter, 100+ men donate \$100 each. Candidates for receiving the donation are nominated by any member of the club. One cause is selected through a vote at the meeting, and receives a check for \$10,000+. Since its inaugural year in 2017, 100 Men Club has donated over \$80,000 to 7 charities with 146 sustaining members.

Founding member Chris Charron commented that "My involvement in 100 MEN CLUB has been eye-opening. As a millennial, I've learned about many people who are under-served and overlooked by our society. 100 MEN CLUB is an amazing group of guys committed to make a difference in their lives.
