

## ***100 Men Club donates Over \$13,000 to SLEEP IN HEAVENLY PEACE providing beds to kids in need.***

DETROIT, MI — February 6, 2020 — 100 Men Club, a group of local men committed to making a positive difference within the Metro Detroit communities and their families, announced its latest donation to **SLEEP IN HEAVENLY PEACE** for \$13,700.

At their December meeting, three charities were nominated, and the membership voted to donate that evening's proceeds to SLEEP IN HEAVENLY PEACE. The nomination was made by 100 Men Club member Robert Bilotti, who noted, "The first time I volunteered with SLEEP IN HEAVENLY PEACE, I knew it was the type of organization 100 Men Club likes to partner with. It's well-run, and doing important work in the local community in a very tangible way. I'm so thrilled 100 Men Club has decided to make this contribution."

Sleep in Heavenly Peace is a 100% volunteer-driven and donation-driven organization that "fully believe that a bed is a basic need for the proper physical, emotional, and mental support that a child needs."

Wendell Gramlich, Chapter President, is certain the impact to Detroit-area children and families will be felt immediately. He said, "We normally build 40 beds during a typical build day and deliver them to kids in need in Metro Detroit. With the donation from 100 Men Club, we'll be able to buy much-needed materials, as well provide the bedding and mattresses."

Sleep in Heavenly Peace focuses on creating lasting relationships that allow communities to come together and provide beds for kids in need. Our mission is to make sure "No Kid Sleeps on the floor in our Town."

Each quarter, 100+ men donate \$100 each. Candidates for receiving the donation are nominated by any member of the club. One cause is selected through a vote at the meeting, and receives a check for \$10,000+. Since its inaugural year in 2017, 100 Men Club has donated over \$150,000 to 12 charities with 146 sustaining members.

Club Member Trevor Andrews commented- "I have been a member of 100 Men Club since inception and my experience as a member has been impactful, rewarding and fun. The truly incredible part of the membership is the substantial impact 100 Men Club has on our local community and the charities we support. A simple \$100 donation quarterly per member is pooled together to be donated to a charity of the membership's choosing, which accumulates to a sizeable donation of over \$10,000 per quarter. We

are able to help local, specialized charities that are materially impacted by the support. To add to the benefits of membership, each meeting has an update on previously supported charities which often includes a first-hand account of the impact of our donation on both the charities themselves and the people in need that they serve.
